#### The Problem:


- Students read a lot of information today in short bursts.
- They change channels and multi-task.
- To develop good reading comprehension we want them to sustain interest and finish the novels that they start reading.
- As soon as they are done we want them to have the desire to read another.
- Some classroom teachers are not familiar with current book series choices.
- Most teachers have a wide range of levels in their rooms.

#### **Our Solution**

- Have all students read complete series of books.
- Change one of our Explorations classes to be a book series class for 1<sup>st</sup> grade.
- Have individual goals and rewards.
- Establish grade level benchmarks for success.
- Have all staff members participate for a common mission throughout the school.





#### Clark County School District School-to-School Performance: Winter 2012-2013 Reading - Curriculum Based Measurement


