- We needed to redistribute \$4,000 to general funds from salaries.
 Therefore, our general funds has increased by \$4,000.
- Books that are purchased for Stories and Snacks are allocated from the
 Title 1 office, we cannot redistribute those funds.
- Our School Performance Plan was adjusted to indicate what money will be allocated in our budget to meet our yearly goals.
- Buses for field trips (those that are not overnight field trips) will be paid for by Magnet.
- Parents will still need to pay for any overnight field trips.

- Our next SITE meeting we will discuss how we will use our ELL (English Language Learner) funds.
- Regarding our School Performance Plan, we are still reviewing a phonics program that can be utilized for K-2 and used in interventions. This will allow us to be consistent and increase student performance.
- Phonics Assessments per grade level as of January:
